UNMISS “Protection of Civilians” (PoC) Sites ^[i]

- As of 12 January 2017, a total of number of civilians seeking safety in six Protection of Civilians (PoC) sites located on UNMISS bases is **224,020** including 120,333 in Bentiu, 33,057 in Malakal, 38,942 in Juba UN House, 1976 in Bor, 663 in Melut and 198 in Wau, in Western Bahr El Ghazal adjusted area 28,851.
