### UNMISS “PROTECTION OF CIVILIANS” (PoC) SITES <sup>1</sup>

- As of 19 October, the estimated number of civilians seeking safety in six Protection of Civilians (PoC) sites located on UNMISS bases is 176,565 including 99,930 in Bentiu, 27,950 in Juba UN House, 45,462 in Malakal, 2,289 in Bor, 700 in Melut and 234 in Wau.
