UNMISS "Protection of Civilians" (PoC) Sites i

• As of 24 March 2016, the estimated number of civilians seeking safety in six Protection of Civilians (PoC) sites located on UNMISS bases is **188,144** including 116,538 in Bentiu, 40,448 in Malakal, 27,950 in Juba UN House, 2,289 in Bor, 700 in Melut and 219 in Wau.
