UNMISS “Protection of Civilians” (PoC) Sites ^[i]

- As of 19 May 2016, the estimated number of civilians seeking safety in six Protection of Civilians (PoC) sites located on UNMISS bases is **177,234** including 105,588 in Bentiu, 40,448 in Malakal, 27,990 in Juba UN House, 2,289 in Bor, 700 in Melut and 219 in Wau.
