UNMISS “Protection of Civilians” (PoC) Sites ^[i]

- As of 23 June 2016, the estimated number of civilians seeking safety in six Protection of Civilians (PoC) sites located on UNMISS bases is **160,822** including 97,221 in Bentiu, 32,719 in Malakal, 27,959 in Juba UN House, 2,004 in Bor, 700 in Melut and 219 in Wau.
