### UNMISS “Protection of Civilians” (PoC) Sites

As of 1 November 2018, a total of number of civilians seeking safety in six Protection of Civilians (PoC) sites located on UNMISS bases is **194,747** including 114,525 in Bentiu, 29,190 in Malakal, 32,113 in Juba UN House, 2,267 in Bor, and 147 in UNMISS base and 16,505 in the area adjacent to UNMISS in Wau “.
