



BRIEF ON VIOLENCE AFFECTING CIVILIANS

APRIL TO JUNE 2026

HIGHLIGHTS

- ❖ Between April and June 2026, UNMISS Human Rights Division (HRD) documented 142 incidents of conflict-related violence affecting 872 civilians: 375 killed, 337 injured, 121 abducted, and 39 subjected to conflict-related sexual violence (CRSV).
- ❖ Compared with the previous quarter (January to March 2026), this represents a 31 percent decrease in the number of incidents (from 206 to 142) and a 37 percent decrease in the number of victims (from 1,388 to 872) documented. The number of civilians killed decreased by 51 percent (from 767 to 375) and injured by 26 percent (from 457 to 337). Abductions increased by 30 percent (from 93 to 121) and the number of victims subjected to CRSV decreased by 45 percent (from 71 to 39).
- ❖ Compared with the same quarter in 2025, this represents a 57 percent decrease in the number of violent incidents (from 334 to 142), and a 43 percent decrease in the number of victims (from 1,518 to 872).
- ❖ Community-based militias and/or civil defense groups were accountable for 64 percent of the total number of victims (563 individuals), while the conventional parties to the armed conflict and/or other armed groups accounted for 29 percent (251 individuals), and unidentified and/or opportunistic armed elements accounted for the remaining seven percent (58 individuals)

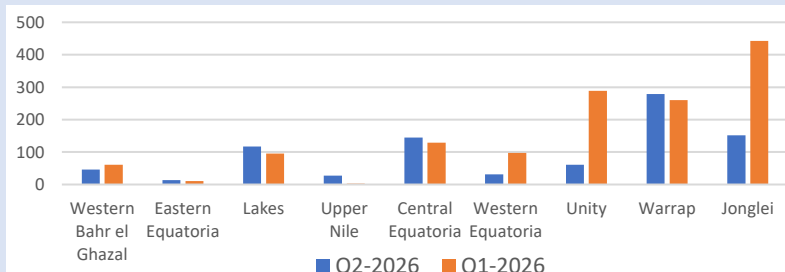

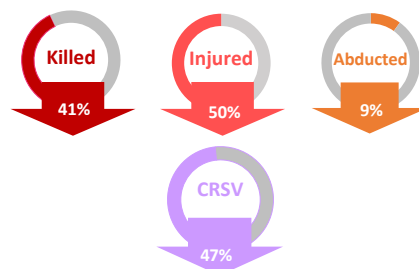


TRENDS IN THE NUMBER OF CIVILIANS AFFECTED BY STATES

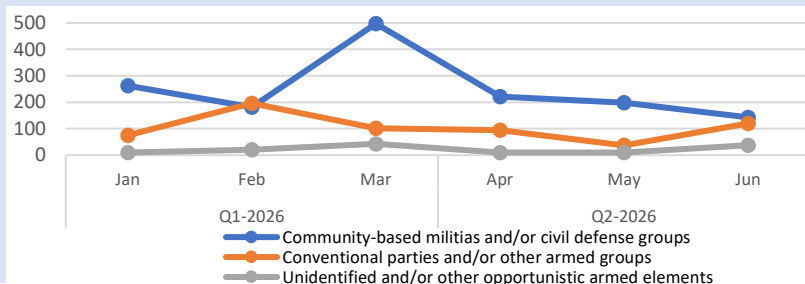


VICTIMS, APR-JUN 25 COMPARED WITH APR-JUN 26

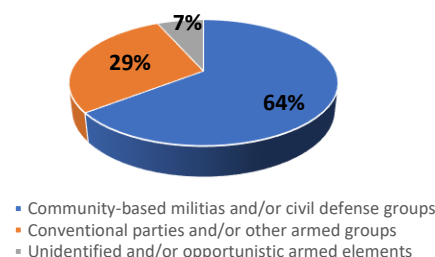


TRENDS IN THE NUMBER OF VICTIMS FROM OCTOBER 2025 TO MARCH 2026
