Impact in Gaza of the 2014 conflict

- 2,251 civilians killed
- 11,231 civilians injured
- 500,000 IDPs during height of conflict. (28% of population)
- 18,000 housing units damaged/destroyed.
- Estimated 7,000 ERW created

- 149 aerial bombs
29,000 kgs net
explosive quantity
- 110,00+ received risk
education
- 974 ERW risk
assessments of 1
million tonnes of rubble.
- 230 EOD call outs






UNMAS Priorities for 2017-18


