UNMISS “Protection of Civilians” (PoC) Sites Population Update*

As of 7 May 2020, the total number of civilians seeking safety in six Protection of Civilians (PoC) sites located on UNMISS bases is 188,649. This includes 118,385 in Bentiu, 27,930 in Malakal, 29,658 in Juba UN House, 1,921 in Bor, and 10,755 in the area adjacent to UNMISS in Wau.
