UNMISS “Protection of Civilians” (PoC) Sites Population Update*

As of 16 April 2020, the total number of civilians seeking safety in six Protection of Civilians (PoC) sites located on UNMISS bases is **190,376**. This includes 118,385 in Bentiu, 27,928 in Malakal, 29,659 in Juba UN House, 1,921 in Bor, and 12,483 in the area adjacent to UNMISS in Wau.
