The United Nations Mission in the Republic of South Sudan (UNMISS) hereby solicit Expression of Interest (EOI) from qualified vendors for the Provision of KU Band Broadcasting Services for the United Nations Mission in South Sudan.

Description of General requirements:

1. UNMISS is looking for a qualified company for the Provision the Provision of KU Band Broadcasting Services. The current UNMISS Radio Broadcasting Services is on "C" band and needs to be uplinked on to KU band with strong footprint/coverage over South Sudan. The KU band signal shall be received with common home satellite KU Band receivers and Systems.
2. The successful vendor will be responsible for:
 - 2.1 Commissioning the KU band Satellite Services.
 - 2.2 Successfully uplink UNMISS Radio Broadcasting Services to KU Band with strong coverage in South Sudan.

Conditions

Interested vendors are invited to submit their EOI by courier, email or hand delivery as indicated below. The EOI must include, as a minimum, the following documentation/information:

1. As a mandatory requirement for UNMISS, before submitting their EOI response, interested service providers are required to be fully registered in the UN Global Marketplace (UNGM) using the link <https://www.ungm.org>.
2. Proof that the vendor is registered in UNGM as a supplier of the items under UN Standard Products and Services Codes (UNSPSC) 25151700 - Satellites.
3. Vendors who are not registered in the UNGM will not be invited to participate in the ensuing solicitation process
