## REQUEST FOR EXPRESSION OF INTEREST

Provision of Solar System Equipment to the United Nations Mission in South Sudan

Closing Date for Receipt of EOI: Friday, 14 August 2015

The United Nations Mission in the Republic of South Sudan (UNMISS) hereby solicit Expression of Interest (EOI) from qualified Contractors for the Provision of Solar System Equipment to the UNMISS Logistics Base, Near Juba International Airport, Juba, South Sudan, as stated herein.

## **Description of General requirements:**

- 1. UNMISS seeks to procure Solar System Equipment (photovoltaic solar panels, solar mounting frames, inverters, remote monitoring and safety accessories etc.) for the UNMISS Geospatial Information and Telecommunications Technologies Section Data Centre.
- 2. Companies interested in this requirement must be in a position to supply and deliver the Solar System Equipment on the basis of Delivered at Place (DAP) UNMISS Logistics Base, Near Juba International Airport, Juba, South Sudan (Incoterms 2010).
- 3. All equipment must come with a minimum warranty of 12 months from the date of receipt of goods by UNMISS.

## **Conditions**

Interested contractors are invited to submit their EOI by courier, email or hand delivery as indicated below. The EOI must include, as a minimum, the following documentation/information:

- 1. As a mandatory requirement for UNMISS, before submitting their EOI response, interested service providers are required to be fully registered as a supplier in the UN Global Marketplace (UNGM) using the link <a href="https://www.ungm.org">https://www.ungm.org</a>.
- 2. Proof that the company is registered for this particular service in UNGM under UN Standard Products and Services Codes (UNSPSC) 26000000 and 26131507.
- UNMISS Procurement Section shall reject any EOI that does not contain the final UNGM vendor registration number under the specified UNSPSC as such submissions will be considered nonresponsive.

This REOI does not constitute a solicitation. UNMISS reserves the right to change or cancel the requirements at any time during the REOI and/or solicitation process. Thus, submitting a response to this REOI does not automatically guarantee that your company will be considered for receipt of the solicitation when issued.
