However at the time of submission of bids, all bidders must be registered at least at level 1 to be considered for award.
- 2. Proof that the company is registered for this particular requirement in UNGM under UN Standard Products and Services Codes (UNSPSC) 51000000 Drugs and Pharmaceutical Products.
- 3. UNMISS Procurement Section shall reject any EOI that does not contain the final UNGM vendor registration number under the specified UNSPSC as such submissions will be considered non-responsive.

This REOI does not constitute a solicitation. UNMISS reserves the right to change or cancel the requirements at any time during the REOI and/or solicitation process. Thus, submitting a response to this REOI does not automatically guarantee that your company will be considered for receipt of the solicitation when issued.
