### UNMISS “PROTECTION OF CIVILIANS” (PoC) SITES <sup>1</sup>

- As of 5 February, the estimated number of civilians seeking safety in seven Protection of Civilians (PoC) sites located on UNMISS bases is 112,887 including 34,674 in Juba UN House, 21,368 in Malakal, 2,649 in Bor, 52,908 in Bentiu, 384 in Wau and 904 in Melut.
