UNMISS “PROTECTION OF CIVILIANS” (PoC) SITES ¹

- As of 11 June, the estimated number of civilians seeking safety in six Protection of Civilians (PoC) sites located on UNMISS bases is 136,590 including 72,643 in Bentiu, 28,663 in Juba UN House, 30,410 in Malakal, 2,374 in Bor, 2,135 in Melut and 365 in Wau.

Bentiu and Malakal

**In Bentiu, 19,735 people have sought protection in UNMISS PoC site since the end of April, putting total numbers up from 52,908 to 72,643.*

Relocation of Internally Displaced Persons (IDPs) to better and higher ground is currently ongoing in Malakal and Bentiu.
