• As of 30 April, the estimated number of civilians seeking safety in six Protection of Civilians (PoC) sites located on UNMISS bases is 119,725 including 52,908 in Bentiu, 34,420 in Juba UN House, 28,717 in Malakal, 2,374 in Bor, 944 in Melut and 362 in Wau.
