UNMISS “PROTECTION OF CIVILIANS” (PoC) SITES ¹

- As of 6 July, the estimated number of civilians seeking safety in six Protection of Civilians (PoC) sites located on UNMISS bases is 153,769 including 91,540 in Bentiu, 28,663 in Juba UN House, 30,410 in Malakal, 2,289 in Bor, 665 in Melut and 202 in Wau.
